## Installation

1. Preparing for installation

A. Disconnect electrical power at fuse or circuit breaker box before installing or servicing any part of this fixture.

B. Carefully remove the fixture from the carton, and check that all parts are included, as shown in figure.2. Mounting & Wiring (all wiring must take place inside junction box)

Caution:Make sure power is off at fuse or circuit breaker box. Check power wires for damage or scrapes. If power supply wires are

within three inches of the ballast power supply, use wire suitable for at least 90C (194F).Note:Most dwellings built before 1985 have supply wire rated to 60C. Consult a qualified electrician before installing.

A. Connect the power source ground wire to the green or bare copper wire from the fixture assembly.

B. Using wire nuts (provided), connect white supply wire to white ballast lead. Connect black supply wire to black ballast lead. Do not mix wires.Pull on each wire lead to make sure connections are secure. Make certain no bare wires are exposed outside of wire connectors.

C. Tuck all connections neatly into junction box (not included).

D. Fasten channel securely to the wall.

E. Install the fixture housing (2) to the plate mounting channel by sliding the slots in the housing over the screws (3) in the channel and tightening
